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TOWN HALL



THE TOWN HALL WAS BUILT IN THE XVIII CENTURY WITH A NEOCLASSICAL STYLE BUT IN THE XIX CENTURY IT WAS REMODELATED. THE FACADE IS ONE OF THE MOST REMARKABLE THINGS. IN IT YOU CAN SEE VARIOUS DECORATIONS; PHOENICIAN COINS HAVE DIFFERENT RELIEFS WITH DIFFERENT SHAPES, EACH ONE WITH A MEANING. THE RELIEF OF HERCULES THAT IS IN THE UPPER PART ALSO STANDS OUT, TECHNICALLY BEING THE FOUNDER OF THE CITY WHEN HE SEPARATED THE TWO CONTINENTS CREATING CÁDIZ; AND WE MUST NOT FORGET THAT THE CLOCK TOWER WHICH IS ON THE TOWN HALL PLAYS A SONG BY MANUEL DE FALLAS EVERY HOUR IN HIS HONOR SO THAT HE IS NOT FORGOTTEN.

EL POPULO



THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF THE POPULO WAS BUILT IN THE 13TH CENTURY AND FROM WHAT IS KNOWN IT IS THE OLDEST IN THE WEST, IT HAS 3 POSSIBLE ENTRANCES ALL IN THE FORM OF ARCHES AND MADE UP OF OYSTER STONES, ALTHOUGH SOME OF THEM ARE FALSE DUE TO THEIR HIGH COST. FORMERLY, THE CASTLE OF THE TOWN WAS LOCATED ON THAT SAME STREET, WHICH WAS SERIOUSLY DAMAGED AND LATER DEMOLISHED BY THE INVASION OF 1596.
