The Cathedral is one of the most impressive monuments in Spain.

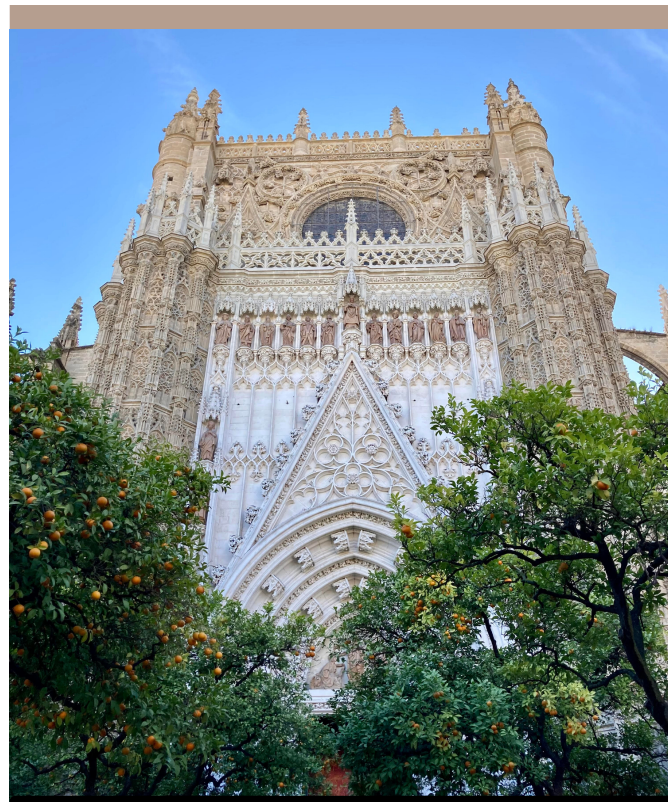
It used to be an almohade mosque but in 1403 it started to be used as a gothic christian temple.
